## Press Realese Foreword by Prof.Erik Spiekermann

However, I wouldn't put it past Alessio to convince some bookbinder to ignore the laws of art, technology, and if need be, gravity. Alessio has what we Germans admire about Italians: namely, a love of life. Everything is possible, even typography is fun!

Günter Gerhard Lange once said "Die Typografie ist eine spröde Geliebte" (Typography is a prude lover). Alessio proves that you help this dry topic if you approach it without the usual heavy hand and weighty theories. This doesn't mean there is an absence of thought or knowledge, the jokes aren't there for the sake of joking (although that wouldn't be a crime), Alessio knows what he is talking about. He has studied the history of writing, but he hasn't forgotten how to ask the same questions a child would ask, a child who won't be fobbed off with references to some higher authority. His disrespectful approach to this noble, academic subject isn't out of disregard for tradition and craftsmanship. Instead, it shows his love for type and typography, and humour brings us closer to this than a proofing loop.
